

Restaurants

The fast-casual and full service restaurant scene in West Midtown is home to a marvelous mixture of local and regional dishes headlined by a curation of several well-known Atlanta based chefs, such as Anne Quatrano and Ford Fry. With sales over \$1,000 psf, considerably exceeding industry standards, West Midtown offers a variety of delicacies, from OK-U's sushi menu and The Optimist's seafood selection to home-cooked burgers at Yeah! Burger and Upbeet's fresh-mixed salad bowls. Moreover, diners have the option of choosing Marcel's Steakhouse, new American-Southern eateries at Miller Union or JCT Kitchen, and upscale Basque tapas or Spanish small plates at Cooks & Soldiers or Barcelona.



Retail

West Midtown contains a unique blend of national fashion and design retailers with the likes of Room & Board, Design Within Reach, Lululemon, and Anthropologie. Moreover, the area is home to Sid & Ann Mashburn and Bungalow Classic, Atlanta's own local take on men's and women's fashion and home décor. All within a two mile radius, consumers have access to complete home and personal fashion from 25 home furnishing, lighting, indoor and outdoor furniture and carpet retail showrooms.



Entertainment

West Midtown is continually adapting to the area's demand of entertainment and lifestyle. Visitors, young professionals, and residents with high discretionary income have a wide array of activities at their disposal, from entertaining clients - or weekend fun - at Top Golf, to catching a flick at the local movie theater, or stimulating their creative side at The Atlanta Contemporary Art Center or the High Museum of Art. 



